### HEATH-LEAFED BANKSIA TREE

An iconic Australian small tree or large shrub, this tree has large striking spikes of yellow to reddish-orange flowers contrasted with small, linear, light-green to greyish-green leaves. A great specimen for attracting birds. Autumn/winter flowering.

This makes a Australian native statement with bold flowering colour and dense form. Ideal for single plantings or multiplanted to make an informal hedge.

This tree enjoys full sun and well-mulched soils. You can lightly prune to retain its bushy habit.
