

Castanea sativa 'Emerald Gem'



EMERALD GEM CHESTNUT TREE

This is a beautiful, spreading, deciduous Chestnut tree that produces prolific fruit which tends to influence nut size. Fruit is medium-sized encased in a burr. Nuts are a distinctive orange-brown in colour. Requires 2 compatible trees to pollinate. Its form has a weeping habit. Foliage is deep green turning in autumn. Medium-sized fruit is encased in burr-cover.

An edible fruiting variety that produces brown nuts used for roasting and cooking after 2-3 years. Matures in April.

Chestnut 'Emerald Gem' grows best in humus-rich soil which is well-draining. Prefers a sunny position.
