











## Acer saccharinum 'Pyramidale'

### PYRAMIDAL SILVER MAPLE TREE

<b>Tree</b>	
<b>Description</b>	This is a large deciduous tree with a columnar form in early years, developing a more rounded crown in maturity making it pyramidal in shape. Foliage is dark green with a grey-white underside. In autumn, foliage turns a yellow and bronze with new spring growth opening in redish-blue tones. Flowers are greenish-yellow but inconspicuous. Considered a fast-growing but shallow-rooted with strong branching roots and fibrous rootlets.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Deciduous
<b>Form</b>	 Round
<b>Mature Size</b>	20 x 12m
<b>Uses</b>	With competitive surface roots, this tree suits areas where fast shade is needed. Pretty autumnal colour makes it an attractive feature.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	This tree is known for having a high tolerance for poor soils, heat and drought.
