Description	A small to medium growing attractive tree that is multistemmed with a rounded shape. The leaves are rounded, glossy green leaves that turn brilliant vivid reds and oranges in autumn. The fruits are samaras (winged shape) that hang in clusters with a red tinge. These appear in summer till autumn.
Foliage	 Deciduous
Form	 V-Shaped
Mature Size	6 x 3m
Uses	A fast growing maple, this tree can be grown with a single leader or with multiple stems. A great selection for deciduous hedging.
Position & Soil	Performs best in full sun. Tolerates a broad range of soil and climatic conditions including relatively wet sites.
