### **FOREST SHEOAK TREE**

<b>Tree</b>	
<b>Description</b>	This tree has a corky light brown bark that has deep fissures. The leaves are thin green needles like a pine tree. There are female and male trees with gold male flowers in Autumn and female rounded warty cones. In Winter the branchlets turn a beautiful copper colour.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Evergreen
<b>Form</b>	 Pendulous
<b>Mature Size</b>	10 x 7m
<b>Uses</b>	Ideal for dry areas and a great street tree where there are no overhead wires. Fantastic specimen tree for medium to large gardens.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	A hardy tree in most soils and aspects. Can handle little moisture and very poor soils.
<b>Features</b>	 Medium  Evergreen  Pendulous  Bird Attracting  Coastal  Informal Screening  Native  Shade Tree
