CANARY ISLANDS STRAWBERRY TREE,
CANARY MADRONE

This tree has bold dark-green foliage and produces large panicles of pink bell-like flowers throughout the year and somewhat knobbly-looking fruit that turn orange-red over time. The bark of this tree is showy, changing from dark orange in most seasons to mid-purple depending on extreme heat and sun. The trunk is smooth with shedding bark.
