Tree	
Description	This Australian native tree has a dense growth habit with long green leaves bearing silver undersides. The leaves can have spiky or smooth margins. The large yellow cylinder shaped flowers are a stunning feature to the tree and attract native birds and insects. The flowers are borne from spring to autumn.
Foliage	 Evergreen
Form	 Broad-domed
Mature Size	5 x 4m
Uses	Can be used in native gardens and coastal areas. Anywhere with dry conditions. Great for street planting.
Position & Soil	Tolerates dry conditions and coastal exposure in a well drained soil. Does not tolerate waterlogging or high phosphorus fertilisers. A native fertiliser is recommended. A full sun position is preferred but part shade is tolerated.
