Description	This is an attractive shrub or small tree with a weeping habit. The leaves are green in colour, long and thin, with tiny hairs. Lovely crimson bottlebrush flowers appear in Spring and Summer, although it is known to spot flower throughout the year, attracting nectar loving birds.
Foliage	 Evergreen
Form	 Pendulous
Mature Size	5 x 5m
Uses	Like most Callistemon varieties, this tree makes a good informal hedge or specimen tree in a native landscape. Adds great habitat for native fauna.
Position & Soil	Likes a well-drained moist soil in a sunny position. Frost tolerant but may require watering in periods of long drought.
