Fruit is produced in autumn after flowers are finished. Nuts grow in a prickly golden casing. This tree has an upright habit. Requires 2 compatible trees to pollinate.

Uses	An edible fruiting variety that produces dark nuts used for roasting and cooking after 2-3 years. Matures early April.
