Description	Red River Gums are widespread in the Australian landscape, most commonly found along stream banks and rivers or in flood plains. They grow very tall with most trees exhibiting a stripy bark revealing pale grey, charcoal and occasionally pink colourings. Foliage is relatively short and narrow.

Uses	As a big tree, it is most suitable for developments and landscapes that require a big native tree.
Position & Soil	While they tolerate most soil types, River Red Gums prefer well-drained sites in full sun or part shade.
