<b>Description</b>	An upright bushy evergreen shrub or small tree with deep olive glossy leaves and attractive brown bark. The foliage is dense and produces small flowers in spring and summer. It is followed by dark purple berries.

<b>Mature Size</b>	5 x 3m
<b>Uses</b>	This variety makes an attractive tree for small gardens and can be easily formed into a hedge.
