**GLENGARRY APRICOT TREE (LOW-CHILL)**

<b>Tree</b>	
<b>Description</b>	This is a heavy cropping variety of Apricot with small golden fruit with a slight blush. A large, vigorous tree. Glengarry works well in both cold-temperate, warm-temperate and some subtropical climates, as it requires low chill hours.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Deciduous
<b>Form</b>	 Round
<b>Mature Size</b>	3 x 3m
<b>Uses</b>	Good for fresh fruit, jams and preserves. As a low-chill variety, this is one of a few varieties of Apricot that will produce fruit in the subtropics. Glengarry is also the best cold-hardy Apricots for cold-temperate areas.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	Plant in a sunny position with well-drained soil. Fertilise and prune every year to encourage new growth and fruit the following year.
