<b>Description</b>	An old variety that produces sweet peaches with a white flesh and ruby-red skin around January and february. Self-fertile.
<b>Foliage</b>	
<b>Form</b>	 V-Shaped
<b>Mature Size</b>	3-5 x 3m
<b>Uses</b>	This tree growing to 5m is great for small or medium gardens. The fruit is juicy and sweet - perfect for eating.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	Prefers a sunny position in a humus rich soil. Requires annual pruning to keep its strong form and shape and to ensure it crops the following year.
