Description	This tree is similar to the English Oak but with a column like habit. It has dense upright branching with dark green foliage. The leaves turn from green to yellow then yellow to brown before dropping. Produces brown acorns.

Mature Size	13 x 4m
Uses	A great tree for Medium gardens. Good for street planting and parks. Could also be used as screening tree due to its dense foliage.
Position & Soil	Tolerates a wide range of soils but prefers a well drained soil in a full sun position. Can tolerate air pollution and short dry periods.
