



## **Sophora (syn. Styphnolobium) japonica 'Princeton Upright'**

PRINCETON UPRIGHT PAGODA TREE

<b>Tree</b>	
<b>Description</b>	As the name suggests, this variety has an upright growing habit. Foliage is generally bright green changing to a beautiful yellow in autumn. In summer, creamy white flowers appear which are pea-shaped. Green pods follow that turn yellow and then brown. This is an attractive feature tree to 12m tall.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Deciduous
<b>Form</b>	 Branches Ascending
<b>Mature Size</b>	12 x 6m
<b>Uses</b>	A narrower form of the classic tree with upright ascending branches.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	Full sun to part shade.
